

2016 CPIC Post-Graduate Fellowships: Overview and Expectations

CPIC Post-Graduate Fellows will have access to several resources including:

- 1) Alumni/ae and community events happening in the fellow's metro area
- 2) Specialized mentor matching based on the fellow's professional goals and interests
- 3) Continuous support during the fellowship year from staff and alums
- 4) An online community of Harvard grads engaged in public service around the world

CPIC Post-Graduate Fellows are expected to:

- 1) Stay engaged and serve as a resource to CPIC staff and students (this helps CPIC to assess and maintain community partnerships)
- 2) Complete a pre-program survey by September 1, 2016 and a post-program survey by August 31, 2017
- 3) Register for a mentor ([click here to register](#)) and meet with their mentor regularly (based on the frequency selected during registration)
- 4) Attend a kickoff meeting with alums in September 2016 (if this is offered in the fellow's metro area); future events in each metro area over the course of the fellowship year will be determined by fellows and alums who attend the kickoff meeting!
- 5) Submit a 250-500 word reflection paper about their post-graduate experience by August 31, 2017
